CIF Ayurveda Speaker Series Session - 25

'One Earth, One World Health Order'



The 25th and the concluding session of CIF Ayurveda Speaker Series, held on December 5th had as its theme - Basic and Fundamental Research for Ayurveda - Modern Medicine Integration.

Opening the session, Satish Thakkar, Chair, CIF, thanked the key people and organizations that made the series possible, like Vaidya Harish Verma of Canadian Ayurvedic Practitioners Association, Vedic Spiritual Heritage Foundation and the Consul General of India in Toronto. Stating that Ayurveda literally means the science of life, he pointed out the need for a well-designed, rigorous research program to validate many of the claims on behalf of Ayurveda. "That is why this year, we launched a \$1 million dollar research fund in partnership with the University Health Network (UHN) that will undertake the necessary research projects in collaboration with leading institutions like All India Institute Ayurveda (AIIA), India. The research will focus on the efficacy of integrated medicine approaches on chronic diseases like diabetes, cancer, kidney and cardiovascular diseases." (Read More)
