Murmu, 64, won by a huge margin against Sinha after receiving over 64 per cent valid votes in the counting of ballots of MPs and MLAs, that continued for over 10 hours, to succeed Ram Nath Kovind. Dr. Sudip Shekhar is 1st Indo Canadian to win global award for pathbreaking research



TORONTO: An Indian-origin professor has become the first Canadian to win a global award for potentially pathbreaking interdisciplinary research. Dr Sudip Shekhar, associate professor in the department of electrical and computer engineering at the University of British Columbia's (UBC) faculty of applied science, will receive \$2.5 million for his research on a "highly compact biomedical sensor that can make medical diagnosis much faster, easier and cheaper than it has ever been", according to a release from UBC.

He is one of the 10 researchers selected for the 2022 cohort of the Schmidt Science Polymaths award. That programme "makes long-term bets on recently-tenured professors with remarkable track records, promising futures, and a desire to explore risky new research ideas across disciplines". Biden naming Dr. Arati Prabhakar as science and technology advisor

President Joe Biden intends to nominate Indian American scientist Dr. Arati Prabhakar to serve as Director of the Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) as also Assistant to the President for Science and Technology. India born daughter of



immigrant parents would make history as the first woman, immigrant, or person of color to head OSTP.

Prabhakar will also be the President's Chief Advisor for Science and Technology, a co-chair of the President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology, and a member of the President's Cabinet, the White House announced June 21. (Read more)
